Here at Casa De Flores it is important to all, who choose to make our community their home, to reside in a peaceful safe environment. In this environment there is never room for disruptive behavior in any form. The rights of all who work and live at Casa De Flores must always take precedence over willful misconduct of any individual.

Code of Conduct

Our community thrives best in a positive, cheerful setting where all residents, their family members and friends feel at home. In order to create this relationship between home and comfort every person is expected to be courteous and respectful to one another and our staff. Any behavior that is disrespectful, unsafe or inconsiderate of residents, friends, and family and Casa De Flores staff will not be tolerated.

Visitation/Resident Sign Out Policy

The safety of Casa De Flores residents is of the upmost importance to us and in harmony with that is our goal to inspire independence through community activities as well as interaction with family and friends. Therefore, even though there are no set visitation hours, we need to encourage safety through good communication. In order for staff to know which residents are not on property, in the case of emergencies, when a resident leaves the facility they must be signed out at our reception desk. The community staff must be made aware of any all day or overnight absences that are planned particularly so that physician prescribed medications can be provided for the time the resident is out of the facility.

Smoke Free Community

Casa De Flores is a smoke free community. While there is a small designated smoking area at the front of the Bayside Care Center, adjacent to Casa De Flores, it is a courtesy of Bayside Care Center and can be disallowed at the discretion of the administrators. Smoking in rooms, or property outside of the designated area is not allowed.

Room Maintenance

Casa De Flores respects the privacy and right of each resident to keep their apartment in an order of their choosing, however, residents must maintain their apartment in a manner that is sanitary and does not create any kind of pest or fire hazard for their rooms or others and that does not prohibit or impair emergency personnel access as well as keeping all egress accessible at all times.
